

NTA Policy Regarding Tournaments Points Awarding System

The NTA has established a policy and tournament point awards system taking into account past established system to which changes are being made to ensure fair point awarding. This system takes into account the past system, three types of tournament grades, international practices and clear distinction between local tournaments in Nepal and internationally recognized tournament participation.

Tournament Points Awarding Policy: “In order to promote the growth in tennis in Nepal and for the benefit of the players, NTA will establish a fair tournament points awarding system that promotes and encourages Nepal’s player participation in the international tennis arena, and one that incorporates local and international events, ensuring a balance between all types of locally and internationally sanctioned events.”

The following are the procedures and regulations adopted by NTA to undertake the above policy implementation.

1. All national tournaments in Nepal will be graded with varying points based on the numerous factors as determined under the Tournament Grading Policy and Regulations.
2. The practice of awarding a uniform point award system will be changed as per the new point awarding system for Juniors and Masters (35+,45+,55+,65+,70+) categories and for Men / Women tournaments are according to the Prize money provided by the organizer.
3. To encourage international participation, and also with the understanding that international points (WTTJ/ATP/WTA/ITF - ATF Junior) will be added to the national ranking points.
4. To encourage players to travel for international pro events, the round based points will be multiplied by a 2 factor for each round achieved at the singles/doubles international level. For example, if an NTA round of 32 is awarded 25 points then any ITF/WTA/ATP pro event qualification round 1 will receive $25 \times 2 = 50$ points and added to his/her total NTA points.
5. NTA ranking will take into account the points of best 8 (eight) tournament results played in National level or National level and International level. If the number of National level exceeds than 8 (eight) tournaments, then the countable number will also exceed accordingly.
6. All players will need to inform and submit their results from international events to have their national points updated by the Monday of their recently completed event in order to ensure their points and ranking are reflected accurately.
7. A total of approximated 15 months is considered for accumulation of points. However, any event will not be counted twice within the 15 month period. If so, the most recent event point will be counted. And only in the case of National Games points earned will stay till the next National Games.
